


How to Separate & Dispose of Household Trash

Basic Rules

- ① Please place your trash at the collection point between sunrise and 8:30 AM on collection day. Please refrain from disposing of trash the night before.
- ② The types of trash to be collected vary by the day of the week. Other types of trash will not be collected on those days, so please separate your trash before disposing of it, and dispose of your trash on the correct collection day.
- ③ Please use transparent or translucent plastic bags as your trash bags. Trash in trash bags, cardboard boxes, etc. that do not allow the contents to be seen will not be collected.
- ④ Please retrieve any uncollected trash from the collection point yourself and separate it properly before disposing of it again.
- ⑤ Please do your part in maintaining the collection points that you use. Collection points are maintained and managed by the people that use them.
- ⑥ Rechargeable batteries can catch fire after they are disposed of. When disposing of rechargeable batteries and devices that require charging, please be sure to use up all of the power, then place them in individual plastic bags and dispose of them on the collection day for non-burnable trash.
- ⑦ When disposing of large amounts of trash due to reasons such as moving house, etc., please divide it into smaller portions, or contact a private waste collection and transport company regarding disposal.
